He highlighted the production of 1.5 million cu.m. of gas till date against a target of producing 3.5 million cu.m. of gas by end of 2012. Further to this, he pointed out that the progress was being hampered due to local problems caused by people and the Stay Order imposed by the Delhi High Court on the legal issues involving ECL, though GEEC had already invested Rs.800 Crores in this project. The Chairman requested ECL to provide a copy of the Stay Order and assured that The matter would be looked into and he would discuss the matter with the Advocate general. 40.04.07 : Shri D.
